

## Two-Year Public Sector Report

The items below reflect actions taken over the course of the year.

- I attended all board meetings
- The board was notified of two-year public sector staff changes and celebrations during board meetings
- I brought to the boards attention concerns about how the Nebraska tribal colleges are classified. Both are considered private institutions by the state of Nebraska, however on the federal level they are considered public institutions.
  - Recently I was asked by one of the institutions to include them on email correspondence so they could network with Colleagues from multiple sectors as there is not one sector that is the best fit
- In August the 2 year public sector had a zoom open forum to discuss use of HEERF III funds and the verification waiver.
- At the Spring Conference association meeting we discussed a variety of topics.
  - The two-year sector members were not opposed to the RMASFAA state swap idea, however it was asked who would represent our state. Best practice was agreed upon for this to be the president/ president-elect or PDRC chair so the insight gained could be directly applied to our own conferences
  - We discussed Afghan Parolee status as an eligible non-citizen for TIV purposes, which as not yet been clearly established by ED
  - Shared best practices for FAA homeless youth determinations
  - There was a discussion about scholarship certificates being sent to high schools by financial aid offices
  - Over the course of the next year we will schedule a quarterly networking zoom for the sector
